Pass ates on credentialing examinations and license acquisition (Cohorts:1-6)

The program annually surveys all its graduates and requests updates on examinations taken, pass rates for examinations and certifications and licensing documentations. data is gatheredvia an annual survey and eview of RIDepartment of Health, which lists active Licensed Mental Health we elors in the state. Because this information is based on the voluntary sharing of alumni data and program efforts to review state records, it is necessarily incomplete. As of the writing of this report, 49 graduates have passed the NCMHCE credentialing exam and are Licensed Mental Health Counselors in Rhode Island. Two graduates are Licensed Professional Counselors in Counselors in the 151 eligible graduates from the first six cohorts. (Cohort 6 became eligible 2023).
